



**CCC Castles Tour No.3**

**Sunday 20th May 2018**

## **REGULATIONS**

### **1. Announcement**

Coltness Car Club Ltd. will promote the CCC Castles Tour No.3 on Sunday 20th May 2018. The event will start and finish at Dalsarf Bowling Club, Ashgillhead Road, Ashgill, Larkhall ML9 3AF.

### **2. Jurisdiction**

The event will be held under the general rules of the MSA as a Touring Assembly and these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event. An MSA Touring Assembly Permit has been applied for.

### **3. Eligibility**

The event is open to all members and non-members of Coltness Car Club. In the event of a full entry, priority will be given to fully paid up members of Coltness Car Club.

### **4. Vehicles**

The event is open to all motor vehicles, of any age, that are legal for use on the public highway. Vehicles must have valid road fund licence and if, required, a current MOT certificate. Cars must comply with the MSA regulations for the event. All tyres used must be road legal. A warning triangle must be carried.

### **5. Route, Navigation & Driving Behaviour**

The route will cover approximately 220 miles on public A and B class roads and unclassified roads in Lanarkshire, Ayrshire and Dumfries & Galloway. The route will be on sealed surfaces, however you should note that some of the roads are narrow and uneven and care should be exercised, particularly with wide or low slung vehicles. The route will be defined by a route book which will be provided at signing-on. Participants must at all times comply with the Road Traffic Acts and drive in a responsible and considerate manner. Failure to do so may result, after an official warning, in exclusion from the event.

### **6. Entry List & Entries**

The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and entry form. All entries must be made on the official Entry form and be accompanied by the appropriate fee. Verbal entries will not be accepted. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. The maximum number of entries is 40. Any entries received after maximum has been reached will be placed on a reserve list. Entries will close at 18:00 on Wednesday 16th May 2018.

The entry fee is £40 for a crew of 2 and includes Rally Plates, Route Book, Points of Interest Book and finisher awards. Refreshments and snacks will be provided at the halfway halt along with a buffet at the finish. Additional crew members can be added at a fee of £10 per additional crew member.

Participants are responsible for ensuring that all drivers and vehicles entered in the event are fully covered by insurance during the event as required by the Road Traffic Acts and will be required to sign a declaration to that effect at the start. A minimum of Third-Party Insurance for all persons who will drive participating vehicles must be applicable for the duration of the event. All crew members will also be required to sign a declaration at the start on the signing-on sheet indemnifying the organisers and the Motor Sports Association from any liability.

#### **8. Documentation & Scrutineering**

Document inspection, signing on and scrutineering will take place at Dalserf Bowling club between 08:30 and 09:30 on Sunday 20th May 2018.
