



Media Accreditation

Although the McRae Gravel Challenge on Saturday 23rd September is not a round of any national or regional rally championship, strict rules will still be applied for those members of the Press and Media who may wish to attend for professional reasons.

The organisers of this event will endeavour to assist those who hold MSA Level 2 Media Accreditation within the current Motor Sports Association guidelines.

Those who do not hold MSA Level 2 accreditation will be restricted as per the official MSA guidelines.

Those others who do not have any form of MSA media accreditation may still apply for event accreditation if attending on behalf of a recognised publication, TV or radio outlet. If representing a website, this application will be subject to the approval of the event organisers who will inspect the contents of the website and assess its news/interest/content value to the sport. (The organisers' decision will be final).

The organisers would like to apologise for these very severe restrictions, but the sport is now operating under new rules.

If anyone turns up on the day and expects to be fast-tracked - DON'T. Supporting documents and/or commissions will require to be checked.

All those requiring a Media Pass on the day will be asked to sign the official MSA Media registration form in Rally HQ before venturing out to the service area or stage.
